**NOTICE OF SENTENCING ENHANCEMENT PURSUANT TO THE  
RHODE ISLAND HATE CRIMES SENTENCING ACT**

Now comes the Attorney General of the State of Rhode Island and pursuant to Rhode Island General Law § 12-19-38, as amended, hereby gives the following notice:


1. The above named defendant has been charged by complaint with one count of disorderly conduct, in violation of Rhode Island General Law § 11-45-1(a).
2. That with respect to the sole count of the complaint, it is alleged that the above named defendant intentionally selected the persons, Adote Akpabie and Maria Akpabie, against whom the offense was committed, and selected the property that was damaged or otherwise affected by these offense, because of the defendant's hatred or animus toward the actual or perceived religion, color, race, national origin or ancestry of Adote Akpabie and Maria Akpabie; and,
3. That upon conviction of this offense, notice is hereby served that the Defendant is subject to the imposition of an additional sentence pursuant to Rhode Island General Law §12-19-38(c).


