Care New England Health System

Care New England Health System (“CNE”) is a Rhode Island non-profit corporation incorporated on November 7, 1995. CNE is headquartered in Providence, Rhode Island and operates a health care system serving Rhode Island. CNE is tax exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

CNE is the sole member of the following entities:

(1) **Kent County Memorial Hospital** (“Kent”) is a Rhode Island non-profit corporation formed on April 25, 1946. Kent is a general hospital located in Warwick, Rhode Island and provides a full range of services for the acute care of patients. Kent provides a full complement of inpatient services including: cardiology and extended coronary care, infectious disease, primary care, geriatrics, oncology, orthopedics, obstetrics and gynecology, rehabilitation and surgery. In addition, Kent offers a comprehensive range of outpatient services, including primary care (adult and pediatric), internal medicine, dermatology, oncology and hematology, orthopedics and sports medicine, pulmonary and sleep medicine, cardiology and cardiac catheterization, chemotherapy, diagnostic imaging, surgery, and rehabilitation services. Outpatient services are provided in the following Rhode Island-based locations: Warwick, Pawtucket, Providence, and Cranston.

Kent has the following affiliated entities:

Kent Hospital Foundation is a Rhode Island non-profit corporation formed on November 29, 2000, and its sole corporate member is Kent. Kent Hospital Foundation was organized to further the mission of Kent, being to serve the health care needs and improve the health status of persons in Kent County Rhode Island, and its environs, and to engage in such activities as related thereto, including without limitation education and research. While the Kent Hospital Foundation’s primary purpose is to provide Kent with unparalleled philanthropic support, the role of the members of the Kent Hospital Foundation includes acting as ambassadors for Kent.

Toll Gate Indemnity, Ltd. (“Toll Gate”) is an offshore captive insurance company located in the Cayman Island, established in 2004 and wholly owned by Kent. Toll Gate provides indemnity coverage for Kent’s and certain wholly-owned hospital affiliates’ professional and general liability risk. Toll Gate also serves as the funding vehicle for Kent’s professional liability indemnification program offered to qualified community faculty physicians (voluntary physicians) affiliated with Kent who wish to participate. The voluntary physician program is offered pursuant to a Rhode Island statute (RIGL §27-16-2.6) that permits a hospital affiliated with an accredited medical school to indemnify physicians for professional liability claims. Kent charges physicians for indemnification coverage, and Kent maintains the reserve fund required in connection with offering an indemnification program pursuant to RIGL §27-16-2.6.

Affinity Physicians, LLC d/b/a Care New England Medical Group (“CNEMG”) is a Rhode Island limited liability company formed on May 12, 2010 and its sole member is Kent. CNEMG offers primary care and specialty services in offices throughout Southern New England. Women & Infants Hospital of Rhode Island, Kent County Memorial Hospital, Butler Hospital and Integra Community Care Network, LLC engage CNEMG to perform professional services through CNEMG-employed or contracted providers.

Kent Ancillary Services, LLC is a Rhode Island limited liability company formed on June 25, 2003 and operates lab drawing stations in furtherance of, and to carry out and support the purposes of, Kent.

Care New England Pharmacy, LLC (“CNE Pharmacy”) is a Rhode Island limited liability company formed on October 2, 2019 and its sole member is Kent. CNE Pharmacy is an ambulatory and specialty pharmacy. CNE Pharmacy serves as a 340B contract pharmacy for the covered entities, Kent and WIH. It is located at the main entrance of Kent (in Warwick) and has prescription pickup centers at WIH, Butler, and in Pawtucket. The CNE Pharmacy provides prescriptions to patients upon discharge, provides service to the employees of CNE, and fills 100% of medication needs for the VNA of CNE Hospice. The

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pharmacy offers non-sterile compounding, adherence packaging, and free home delivery via pharmacy technicians or mail through the United States Postal Service.

(2) **Women & Infants Corporation (“WIC”)** is a Rhode Island non-profit corporation formed on March 2, 1987 and is the sole member of Women & Infants Hospital of Rhode Island. The mission of WIC is to support Women & Infants Hospital of Rhode Island and its other affiliated organizations.

Women & Infants Hospital of Rhode Island (“WIH”) opened in 1884 as the Providence Lying-In Hospital, and its initial purpose was limited to the delivery of babies. Currently, WIH is the 8th largest stand-alone obstetrical service in the nation, the largest in New England and delivers 8,500 infants each year. WIH operates its main facility on property leased from Rhode Island Hospital in Providence, Rhode Island. WIH has 247 licensed beds, which includes 80 neonatal intensive care unit (“NICU”) beds. WIH also owns and leases a number of other facilities surrounding the existing campus as well as other facilities a short distance away in Providence. WIH offers a full range of obstetrics and gynecology specialty services for women of all ages and has one of the nation’s largest single-family room neonatal intensive care units for babies born prematurely or critically ill. WIH services include behavioral health, breast health, cancer care, cardiology, child and family development, diagnostic imaging, emergency care, family medicine, fertility, gastroenterology, high-risk obstetrics, imaging, infectious disease, laboratory services, obstetric and consultative medicine, obstetrics, pediatrics, primary care, reproductive endocrinology, surgical services, and uro-gynecology. WIH serves as the tertiary care center for neonatology, obstetrics, maternal fetal medicine and gynecology for all of the State and portions of the neighboring states of Massachusetts and Connecticut. WIH offers educational programs and a wide range of medical, nutritional and support services through the Obstetrics and Gynecology Care Center and its outreach sites in East Greenwich and South Kingstown, Rhode Island.

WIH has the following affiliated entities:

W&I Indemnity, Ltd. (“W&I Indemnity”) is an offshore captive insurance company located in the Cayman Island, established in 1994 and wholly owned by WIH. W&I Indemnity provides indemnity coverage for WIH’s professional liability risk and Butler’s excess professional liability risk. W&I Indemnity also serves as the funding vehicle for WIH’s professional liability indemnification program offered to qualified community faculty physicians (voluntary physicians) affiliated with WIH who wish to participate. The voluntary physician program is offered pursuant to a Rhode Island statute (RIGL §27-16-2.6) that permits a hospital affiliated with an accredited medical school to indemnify physicians for professional liability claims. WIH charges physicians for indemnification coverage, and W&I Indemnity maintains the reserve fund required in connection with offering an indemnification program pursuant to RIGL §27-16-2.6.

Women & Infants’ Ancillary Services, LLC is a Rhode Island limited liability company formed on September 5, 2003 and operates lab drawing stations in furtherance of, and to carry out and support the purposes of, WIH.

Women & Infants Development Foundation is a Rhode Island non-profit corporation formed on March 2, 1987, and its sole corporate member is WIH. Women & Infants Development Foundation was organized to serve the health needs and improve the health care status of individuals, and to engage in such activities as will further the clinical, education and research purpose of WIH. While Woman & Infants Development Foundation’s primary purpose is to provide WIH with unparalleled philanthropic support, the role of the members of the Women & Infants Development Foundation includes acting as ambassadors for WIH.

Women & Infants Health Care Alliance, LLC is inactive.

Women & Infants Physician Hospital Organization, Inc. is inactive.

WIH Faculty Physicians, Inc. (“FPI”) is a Massachusetts non-profit corporation formed on October 12, 2001. FPI was formed to facilitate the provision of professional services in Massachusetts and

Connecticut. FPI engages CNEMG to perform professional services through CNEMG-employed or contracted providers

(3) **Butler Hospital** (“Butler”) is a Rhode Island non-profit corporation formed on January 2, 1884 and is currently, Rhode Island’s only non-profit, free-standing psychiatric hospital that provides adults, seniors and adolescents specialized assessment and treatment for all major psychiatric illnesses and substance abuse. Butler also provides inpatient detoxification services, a partial hospital rehabilitation program, intensive outpatient services and outpatient medication assisted therapy providing both Vivitrol and Suboxone induction and maintenance. Butler is the major affiliated teaching hospital for psychiatry and behavioral health of The Warren Alpert Medical School of Brown University and is the flagship hospital for its Department of Psychiatry and Human Behavior. In addition, Butler is the major training site and the base hospital for the Brown University General Residency in Psychiatry.

Butler has the following affiliated entities:

Butler Hospital Foundation is a Rhode Island non-profit corporation formed on December 5, 2011 and its sole corporate member is Butler. Butler Hospital Foundation was organized to serve the health needs and improve the behavioral status of individuals, and to engage in such activities as will further the clinical, education and research purpose of Butler Hospital. While Butler Hospital Foundation’s primary purpose is to provide Butler with unparalleled philanthropic support, the role of the members of the Butler Hospital Foundation includes acting as ambassadors for Butler.

Carriage House, LLC is a Rhode Island limited liability company formed on January 22, 2007 and organized to acquire and invest in medical office building(s) and to provide administrative services thereto.

Harbor Group Home, LLC is a Rhode Island limited liability company formed on January 24, 2001 and Butler is the owner of a 1% membership interest.

Butler Hospital Allied Medical Services, LLC is inactive.

(4) **Care New England Ambulatory Surgery Center** (“CNE ASC”) is Rhode Island non-profit corporation formed on July 13, 2020. CNE filed a Certificate of Need Application seeking to create a multispecialty freestanding ambulatory surgery center (“ASC”) in Providence, Rhode Island, and the CNE ASC entity was formed as the entity to operate the ASC. If the Certificate of Need is approved, the CNE ASC will be equipped to accommodate an array of outpatient surgical cases across a number of specialties, including orthopedics, general surgery, plastic surgery, vascular surgery and urology, with the ability to adapt to evolving trends in ambulatory surgical care. The purpose of CNE ASC is to fill an unmet need for lower-cost, ambulatory operating rooms in the region and to provide enhanced quality and lower cost care for individuals in the communities CNE’s affiliates serve.

(5) **The Providence Center, Inc.** (“TPC”) is a Rhode Island nonprofit corporation formed on June 29, 1971 and is currently the largest community-based behavioral healthcare organization in Rhode Island. Founded as a community mental health center based in Providence, Rhode Island, TPC’s mission is to help people affected by mental health, behavioral health and substance use problems by providing treatment and supportive services within a community setting. In addition to its counseling and treatment services, TPC offers a wide array of other services, including recovery supports and centers, integrated primary care, permanent supportive housing, medication-assisted treatment, educational and vocational counseling, and wellness services. TPC provides its services in a variety of community-based locations in Providence, Burrillville, Cranston, North Kingstown, Pawtucket, Richmond and Warwick. More than 80% of TPC’s clients have an annual family income of less than \$10,000. TPC provides individualized treatment in the community—in homes, in schools, and in neighborhoods—using evidence-based practices that help people overcome barriers to wellness and success.

TPC has the following affiliated entities:

TPC Social Ventures, Inc. is a Rhode Island nonprofit corporation formed on August 24, 1988 and organized to create and provide job training and vocational opportunities for handicapped and disadvantaged persons, particularly those in need of mental health care.

Continuum Behavioral Health, Inc. (“Continuum”) is a Rhode Island nonprofit corporation formed on May 22, 2013. Continuum is inactive and no longer provides behavioral health services. Behavior health services previously provided by Continuum are provided by Butler Hospital’s Outpatient Department.

Standard Realty, Inc. is a Rhode Island nonprofit corporation formed on June 1, 1982 and organized exclusively for charitable and/or educational purposes; specifically, to operate and maintain HUD-financed housing for individuals with chronic mental health illness.

Grandview Realty Corporation is a Rhode Island nonprofit corporation formed on March 12, 1979 and organized exclusively for charitable and/or educational purposes; specifically, to operate and maintain HUD-financed housing for individuals with chronic mental health illness.

Grandview Second Corporation is a Rhode Island nonprofit corporation formed on May 29, 1987 and organized exclusively for charitable and/or educational purposes; specifically, to operate and maintain HUD-financed housing for individuals with chronic mental health illness.

Nashua Street Corporation is a Rhode Island nonprofit corporation formed on January 14, 2000 and organized exclusively for charitable and/or educational purposes; specifically, to operate and maintain HUD-financed housing for individuals with chronic mental health illness.

Wilson Street Apartments, Inc. is a Rhode Island nonprofit corporation formed on November 27, 2001 and organized exclusively for charitable and/or educational purposes; specifically, to operate and maintain HUD-financed housing for individuals with chronic mental health illness.

(6) **Kent County Visiting Nurse Association d/b/a VNA of Care New England** (“VNA”) is a Rhode Island non-profit corporation formed on March 15, 1971 that provides and administers a comprehensive, multi-disciplinary, therapeutic, hospice and public health nursing program. A staff of highly trained nurses, nurse practitioners, home health aides, physical, occupational and speech therapists, social workers and a chaplain deliver individualized home and hospice care to thousands of adults each year. Services include home health, palliative and hospice services for adults and the elderly. The VNA also offers a comprehensive line of cardiac, pulmonary, rehabilitation and end-of-life home health care services, including hospice care, providing smooth transition through the continuum. Committed to maintaining healthy communities, the VNA offers bereavement support groups and community education sessions at numerous locations. The VNA is licensed by the Rhode Island Department of Health (“RIDOH”) for Home Nursing Care and Hospice. It is accredited by The Joint Commission and was most recently accredited in April 2018.

VNA has the following affiliated entities:

VNA of Care New England Foundation (“VNA Foundation”) is a Rhode Island nonprofit corporation formed on November 7, 2011 and its sole corporate member is the VNA. The VNA Foundation was organized to serve the health needs and improve the health status of individuals and to engage in such activities as will further the clinical purposes of the VNA. While the VNA Foundation’s primary purpose is to provide the VNA with unparalleled philanthropic support, the role of the members of the VNA Foundation also includes acting as ambassadors for the VNA.

HealthTouch, Inc. is inactive.

Blackstone Health, Inc. (“BHI”) is a Rhode Island nonprofit corporation formed on January 8, 1987 and organized to provide community-based health services responsive to the needs and demographic makeup of the Blackstone Valley community and other communities. In furtherance of such purposes, BHI operates meal sites and an adult day care center, and provides nursing, case management, therapeutic recreation, and daily living services for the benefit and welfare of elderly and disabled residents of the communities that it services. BHI holds a food service license (FSV05752) and the adult day care center, which operates under the name “New Horizons Adult Day Care Center,” holds an adult day care center license (ADC00051) and a food service license (FSV20830).

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(7) **Integra Community Care Network, LLC** (“Integra”) is a Rhode Island limited liability company formed May 29, 2014 and operates as an accountable care organization (“ACO”). CNE launched Integra in 2014 initially as a Medicare Certified ACO. Since that time, Integra has entered into ACO type arrangements with commercial and Medicaid payers and now has more than 150,000 attributed lives under management. Its partners include CNE, Rhode Island Primary Care Physicians Corporation (“RIPCPC”) and South County Health. Integra’s participating provider network includes CNE’s hospitals, organizations and providers, as well as those of South County Health and RIPCPC, the Rhode Island’s largest primary care independent practice association. Integra’s goals are aligned with RIDOH’s Triple Aim: improving the patient experience of care; improving the health of populations; and reducing the per capita cost of health care.

Integra enables CNE and its physicians to be prepared for value-based risk sharing agreements within the emerging accountable care provider environment. Integra has shared savings/risk contracts with several public and private payers. In addition, Integra also contributes to the management of health services within CNE’s self-insured employee health plan via a service contract with the CNE plan. Integra’s services include contract negotiation, quality improvement, strategy and analytics, nurse care management, social work, community health support, mobile integrated health, ambulatory pharmacy, referral support, integrated behavioral health and practice support, skilled nursing facility management, and home based care provided by CNE providers in collaboration with Integra nurse care managers.

(8) **Southeastern Healthcare System, Inc.** (“SHS”) is a Rhode Island nonprofit corporation formed on September 16, 1996 and organized to operate for the benefit of and to support the operations of The Memorial Hospital and its affiliated publicly supported organizations and to carry on the following functions: (1) to develop, operate, and maintain an integrated health care system for the delivery of medical and surgical treatment and related health services; (2) to promote medical research and make contributions to scientific medicine; (3) to engage in research and the teaching, instruction and education of medical students and other health care professionals; (4) to provide primary and family care medical facilities on a regional basis; (5) to work cooperatively with other hospitals, community health agencies, educational institutions and other public and private entities to promote standards of health in the community served; and (6) to engage in fundraising activities, and unrelated trade or business, to raise funds for The Memorial Hospital and any other publicly supported affiliated organization organized for the purpose of supporting The Memorial Hospital or for any of the above referenced authorized purposes.

SHS has the following affiliated entities:

Primary Care Centers of New England, Inc. (“PCCNE”) is inactive.

The Memorial Hospital (“MHRI”) is a Rhode Island nonprofit corporation formed on September 29, 1989. MHRI is currently closed, effective as of January 1, 2018. During operation, MHRI was located in Pawtucket, Rhode Island and was organized with the purpose to be a university medical school affiliated institution and to serve as the community health center for the Blackstone Valley community and other communities. MHRI had programs of community outreach and developed training programs with primary care as its focal point. In addition, MHRI provided the highest quality care in its traditional in-patient activities and develop tertiary care capabilities in various areas of medical and surgical specialties.

MHRI has the following affiliated entities:

The Memorial Hospital Foundation (“MHRI Foundation”) is a Rhode Island non-profit corporation formed on July 22, 2013 and its sole corporate member is MHRI. The MHRI Foundation was organized to serve the health needs and improve the behavioral status of individuals, and to engage in such activities as will further the clinical, education and research purpose of MHRI. MHRI Foundation’s primary purpose was to provide MHRI with unparalleled philanthropic support, with the role of the members of the MHRI Foundation was to act as ambassadors for MHRI.

MHRI Ancillary Services, LLC (“MAS”) is a Rhode Island limited liability company formed on December 30, 2010 and prior to the closure of MHRI, operated lab drawing

stations in furtherance of, and to carry out and support the purposes of, MHRI. Since the closure of MHRI, MAS has been inactive.

SHS Ventures, Inc. is inactive.

Boulevard Medical Office Condominium Association is a Rhode Island non-profit corporation formed on March 27, 1992 and organized to provide administration, operation and maintenance of the Boulevard Medical Office Condominiums located in Pawtucket, Rhode Island. MHRI is a 55% shareholder.

Rhode Island PET Services, LLC is a Rhode Island limited liability company formed on January 24, 2002 and provides PET services in Rhode Island. MHRI owns a 1% membership interest.

Hospital Properties, Inc. is a non-profit corporation that owns, manages, and operates real estate related to the corporate mission of Lifespan Corporation and its affiliates.

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C. Newport Health Care Corporation:

Newport Health Care Corporation is a non-profit corporation organized to support, encourage, and coordinate the development of comprehensive, integrated health care related services. Currently, NHHCC holds no assets.

D. Newport Health Property Management, Inc.:

Newport Health Property Management, Inc. is a non-profit corporation organized to own, manage, and operate real estate in the furtherance of the purposes of Newport Health Care Corporation and Lifespan Corporation.

E. Lifespan MSO, Inc.:

Lifespan MSO, Inc. is a non-profit corporation organized to provide practice management services.

F. Lifespan Risk Services, Inc.:

Lifespan Risk Services, Inc. is a for-profit corporation organized to provide incident and claim review and risk management services.

G. RI Sound Enterprises Insurance Co., Ltd.:

RI Sound Enterprises Insurance Co., Ltd. Is a Bermuda Corporation organized to insure Lifespan's professional and general liability exposures including eligible affiliated physician groups.

Lifespan Physician Group, Inc. is a non-profit corporation organized to provide accountable patient-centered, high quality, efficient, value-based and innovative care to serve the health care needs of the communities in Rhode Island and elsewhere, including those served by the hospitals affiliated with Lifespan Corporation, and to promote and advance medical research, education and training in medicine, medical related sciences and clinical practice. It operates physician practices.

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C. Coastal Medical Physicians, Inc. (dba Coastal Medical):

Coastal Medical Physicians, Inc. Alternative Living Concepts (dba Human Services Realty) is a non-profit corporation organized to provide ownership, management, leasing and maintenance of office and residential facilities (which include housing for persons and families of low and moderate income) and equipment used in connection with the operations of Gateway Healthcare, Inc., and other supporting organizations.

VII. Lifespan Joint Ventures

A. Lifespan Health Alliance, LLC

Lifespan Health Alliance is an accountable care organization that participates in the Medicare Shared Savings Program. It is a joint venture of Lifespan Corporation and Community Physician Partners, Inc. Each holds a 50% interest.

B. Lifespan/Physician Professional Services Organization, Inc.

Lifespan/Physician Professional Services Organization, Inc. (the "PSO") is a non-profit corporation that is a joint venture between New England Physician Alliance (50%) and Lifespan Corporation (50%). The PSO was formed to support independent practices and to facilitate contracts between the Lifespan hospitals and those practices. The PSO is no longer active and has not had an operating budget allocated to it or performed any functions since 2016.

C. Orthopedic MRI of Rhode Island, LLC

Orthopedic MRI of Rhode Island, LLC, is a joint venture between Rhode Island Hospital, University Orthopedics, Inc., and Rhode Island Medical Imaging, Inc. Each member has an equal 33⅓ % membership interest. It was created in 2007 to act as a leasing and management organization that provides or arranges for certain items to support the operation of medical imaging services.

VIII. Related Entities-No Ownership/Control

Although the following entities do not meet the definition of an Affiliate, we include them because the Department of Attorney General specifically asked about such entities:

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A. The Miriam Hospital Women's Association

The Miriam Hospital Women's Assn. (TMHWA) is a Rhode Island non-profit corporation established in 1907 by members of the community surrounding The Miriam Hospital to support The Miriam Hospital. TMHWA is a separate organization from The Miriam Hospital, with a distinct tax identification number, and is not controlled or operated by The Miriam Hospital or any other Lifespan affiliate. Because its tax-exempt purpose is to support The Miriam Hospital, TMHWA is listed on The Miriam Hospital's PC 990 as a related entity, but The Miriam Hospital does not own, operate or control TMHWA.

B. Community Physician Partners, Inc.

Community Physician Partners, Inc. ("CPP") is an organization of independent primary care practices formed in 2014 to enter into value-based payor arrangements related to population health. The primary care practices of Lifespan Physician Group and the Women's Internal Medicine practices of the Lifespan Women's Medicine Collaborative participate in CPP payor contracts. However, Lifespan does not own, operate or control CPP.
