That with respect to the two criminal counts charged in the information, it is alleged that this Defendant intentionally selected the persons, Rachael Woda, Kim Campbell and/or Judith Gilson, against whom the offenses were committed, because of the Defendant's hatred or animus toward the actual or perceived disability, religion, color, race, national origin or ancestry, sexual orientation, or gender of Rachael Woda, Kim Campbell and Judith Gilson and/or the owner or occupants of Temple Beth-El in Providence.
- 3. That upon conviction of any of the charged criminal offenses, notice is hereby served that the Defendant is subject to the imposition of an additional sentence pursuant to RIGL §12-19-38(c) and (d).
